Welcome to the National Vetting

The National Vetting Bureau (Children and Vulnerable Persons) Act 2012 provides for the vetting of persons carrying out relevant work with children or vulnerable persons. The Act also creates a new offence for failing to comply with its provisions.

The Act stipulates that a relevant organisation shall not permit any person to carry out relevant work with children or vulnerable persons unless the organisation receives a vetting disclosure from the National Vetting Bureau.

Garda vetting is conducted on behalf of registered organisations on a personal basis.

If you are seeking employment or intending to volunteer with an organisation which conducts relevant work, you may be asked to make an application to be vetted.

You may make an application to be vetted in one of two ways:

 eVetting

or

 Paper application

For the vetting of persons carrying out relevant work with children or vulnerable persons, the Act also creates a new offence for failing to comply with its provisions. The Act stipulates that a relevant organisation shall not permit any person to carry out relevant work with children or vulnerable persons unless the organisation receives a vetting disclosure from the National Vetting Bureau. Garda vetting is conducted on behalf of registered organisations on a personal basis.
